- ▶ The vast majority of California voters are aware of Senate Bill 60—2003 legislation that gave illegal immigrants the right to obtain California Drivers Licenses, but was later repealed.

AWARENESS

- ▶ There is wide opposition to illegal immigrants having the right to obtain California Drivers Licenses.

QUESTION:

Do you support or oppose giving illegal immigrants the right to obtain California Drivers Licenses?

STRONGLY SUPPORT	11.5%	→ 70.5% Oppose
SOMEWHAT SUPPORT	11.5	
SOMEWHAT OPPOSE	13.9	
STRONGLY OPPOSED	56.6	
UNSURE	6.4	

- ▶ Two thirds of voters say they would support a ballot measure restricting the issuance of California Drivers Licenses to citizens and legal residents only.

QUESTION:

Would you support or oppose a ballot measure that would allow the state to issue drivers licenses only to citizens and legal residents?

STRONGLY SUPPORT	50.2%	→ 66.5% Support
SOMEWHAT SUPPORT	16.3	
SOMEWHAT OPPOSE	10.2	
STRONGLY OPPOSED	14.7	
UNSURE	8.5	

The survey of registered California voters who are likely to vote was conducted Monday, January 5 – Thursday, January 8, 2004. A total of 625 voters were polled. A survey of this size yields a margin of error of +/-4%. The survey was conducted in English and Spanish.
